**Stage 1:**

Students must submit a completed nomination form along with a 250-word abstract (2 page maximum), clearly outlining the relevance of their research to BC's environmental industry, how it is innovative, and its potential significance.

Submissions, consisting of the nomination form and abstract, should be submitted in PDF format via email to [workshop@emaofbc.com](mailto:workshop@emaofbc.com).

**Application deadline is December 15, 2021.**

**Stage 2:**

The EMA of BC will notify finalists by January 7, 2022.

Finalists will submit an academic poster to be presented and displayed at the 2022 EMA of BC Workshop at the BCIT Burnaby Campus, BC. Students of the selected posters will attend the workshop to engage with participants and judges. Up to two (2) students per selected poster will be given FREE attendance to the workshop.

**Students will bring their printed poster to the workshop on April 22, 2022.**

Easels will be provided for displaying posters.

Each student may submit one project. Multiple students may submit a joint project.

EMA of BC staff and directors will select and contact the finalists. Three winning projects will be selected and announced publicly at the EMA of BC Workshop on April 22, 2022.
